Code of Ethics

The following are the principles of ethical behavior for those affiliated with International Nepali Literary Society (INLS), Florida Chapter:

1. It is the responsibility of the INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors to maintain a balance between the need in society to use a cultural property (Nepali Language, Literature and culture), and to ensure the preservation of that cultural property.
2. All actions of the INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors must be governed by an informed respect for the integrity of the organization.
3. The INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors shall strive to attain the highest possible standards in all aspects of Nepali language, literature and culture promotion and preservation, including publication, education, research, documentation and organizing workshops.
4. The INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors must recognize their limitations and recognize the special skills, and knowledge of others.
5. The INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors must be sensitive to other language, literature and culture.
6. The INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors must contribute to the promotion of Nepali language, literature and culture by sharing information and experience.
7. The INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors shall act with honesty and integrity in all professional relationships, recognize the rights of all colleagues and respect the mission and the programs of the Chapter.
8. The INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors shall work towards collaborating efforts with other sister organizations globally.
9. The INLS, Florida Chapter executive committee members and advisors have an obligation to comply with and to promote an understanding of this Code of Ethics.
